



Venue Rules and Regulations

Please remember that off road riding can be dangerous, ensure you have read and follow the rules in full in their entirety.

These rules apply to all persons using the site:

1. All riders 16 years and under must be accompanied by and appropriate adult at all times. No children under 6 years allowed to be riding on any part of the property.
2. All persons must wear correct fitting riding gear, Boots, Helmet and Gloves.
3. Riders must not be under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
4. We have an on-site speed limit of 5mph, which must be followed.
5. All riders must ride to their ability, experience and have some riding experience.
6. All riders must sign the Rider Registration Form and Declaration Form before embarking on the course.
7. Ensure you have familiarised yourself with the route you wish to ride and the course. Please bare in mind that the site is home to various Wildlife and the course can frequently be disturbed as per their habitat, such as fresh Rabbit holes etc. Please take care when choosing your route.
8. No riding in the car park or field areas. All riders must give right of way to all equestrian use of the site and be fully respectful of the horses at all times. Failure to comply with this on any occasion will result in that person being barred from the site permanently.
9. The marshals and management have the right to refuse access to any bike, at any time and to exclude any bike, which is considered not to be safe for off road use.
10. All bikes must be in safe working order. It must be fitted with a Lanyard used correctly at all times.
11. You must notify gate staff and list on your entry/registration/declaration form if you are taking any medication or have a specific medical condition. All details will be kept confidential.
12. Staff will be on hand to give any help, advice and guidance, but any liability for injury to person or damage to vehicles arising out of such guidance is expressly excluded.

13. Please familiarise yourself with First Aiders & Marshals on arrival.
14. Please do not drop litter. Use the bins provided or take it home!
15. Please respect that any decision made by the management, organisers, staff or a marshal is final and is to be respected.
16. No refund will be given if a customer's visit has been cut short for whatever the reason.
17. All riders and visitors must keep to the YOTC areas only. Access is forbidden at any time to the Yorkshire Equestrian Centre or the horse areas.
18. If you are found to be ignoring the rules set out, you will be asked to leave the site without reimbursement.
19. Please leave the site by the event closing times. Barriers will be locked and failure to leave promptly will incur parking fees.
