The majority of the test to be ridden as a pair (80%) but may ride separate.
Any movements used must be at BD Novice Level, but not above.
The test starts and finishes with salutes. The time is started at the first salute.

Time Penalty : 2 marks will be deducted if under 4 or over 5 minutes

Penalised moments : 2 marks will be deducted for each prohibited movement performed.

Non-compulsary permitted movements: Circles and half circles of any size / give and retake of the reins / Change of leg through trot / Stretching in trot / Counter canter / More than a few strides of medium trot and canter / Rein back

Prohibited movements: Extended trot & canter / Lateral work of any kind / Pirouettes / Piaffe / Passage / Reins in one hand / Simple changes / Canter to halt / Flying changes /
Half marks may be used.

Optional movements: Those occurring in current unaffiliated and BD tests at Novice Level.

Equality of marks: If two competitors have the same final total the one with the highest marks for artistic will be the higher placed
